2. Approval by the assigned District Judge is required on all cases in which a magistrate judge has been assigned for discovery. However, approval by the assigned District Judge is not required for cases referred to the Magistrate Judge for a Report and Recommendation.
3. Parties are free to withhold consent to magistrate judge jurisdiction without adverse consequences.
4. If all parties consent to the assigned Magistrate Judge, any appeal would be made directly to the United States Court of Appeals.

II. CONSENT TO THE ASSIGNED MAGISTRATE JUDGE

I voluntarily consent to have the assigned United States Magistrate Judge conduct all further proceedings in this case, including a trial, and order the entry of final Judgment.
