

1 an evaluation for purposes of monetary damages only of the plaintiff's claim
2 against the City of Los Angeles.

3 2. At the conclusion of the session, the mediators will make a unanimous
4 written recommendation to counsel for both sides as to the settlement value of
5 the pending lawsuit, including an award of attorney's fees. The mediators will
6 deliver a copy of their recommendation to the plaintiff and will obtain a signed
7 acknowledgment from the plaintiff that plaintiff has received a copy of the
8 unanimous written recommendation.

9 3. Thereafter, each side will have fourteen days to accept or reject the
10 mediator's evaluation and recommendation by notifying the mediators in writing
11 of their position.

12 4. The mediators will forward the plaintiff's signed acknowledgment and
13 each party's acceptance or rejection of the mediators' evaluation and
14 recommendation, under seal, to United States District Judge Dickran Tevrizian,
15 who will coordinate the settlement program for the District Court. Judge
16 Tevrizian will hold the document under seal until the case is either settled or
17 tried. In the case of a trial, the document will be forwarded to the trial judge,
18 who will open it only after the trial has concluded.

19 5. In those cases where the parties wish to pursue settlement through
20 this dispute resolution procedure, the parties are to adhere to the following:

21 (A) The parties are to notify Judge Tevrizian, through his
22 Courtroom Deputy Clerk, of their intention to pursue this form of
23 dispute resolution;

24 (B) The parties are to submit to Judge Tevrizian the names of two
25 retired judges — one from plaintiffs and one from defendants —
26 selected from the attached list.

27 (C) Judge Tevrizian will select a third judge from the list to
28 complete the dispute resolution panel.

(D) Judge Tevrizian will notify the three judges of their selection and the ground rules that apply in these cases. Thereafter, the parties will be responsible for arranging the date and time for the conference.

6. The fees for the mediator's services with respect to these hearings shall be paid by the City of Los Angeles.
