ORDER NO. 11: RESTRUCTURING
LEADERSHIP

ALL CASES

In light of potential resolution of the Consumer Class Actions (Docket No. 107), the Court believes that it is necessary to revisit the leadership structure.

1. The Consumer Class Action appointments which the Court made in Order No. 4 remain in place. However, the activities shall be limited to moving for class certification and approval of the proposed settlement and any actions ancillary thereto until further order of the Court.

2. The Court envisions following structure going forward:

- New Executive Committee consisting of one or more counsel

1 representing Governmental entities and one or more counsel representing the
2 subrogation plaintiffs.

3
4 • Governmental Entities Committee consisting of two or more counsel
5 representing Governmental entities. The committee shall be responsible for
6 managing the Governmental entities track.

7
8 • Subrogation Committee consisting of two or more counsel
9 representing subrogation plaintiffs. The committee shall be responsible for
10 managing the subrogation track.

11
12 • Discovery Committee consisting of one or more counsel
13 representing Governmental entities and one or more counsel representing
14 subrogation plaintiffs. All discovery shall be coordinated by this committee.

15
16 • Expert Committee consisting of one or more counsel representing
17 Governmental entities and one or more counsel representing subrogation plaintiffs.
18 All expert matters including discovery and the preparation and presentation of
19 expert evidence shall be coordinated by this committee.

20 3. No later than June 7, 2023, any counsel may submit comments re
21 the structure proposed in this Order.

22
23 4. No later than June 7, 2023, any counsel may apply for any the
24 positions outlined above. The criteria for appointment shall be that as set forth in
25 Order No. 1, ¶ 2.2. Any counsel who have been previously been appointed or
26 have filed an application for appointment previously need only file a one-page
27 expression of continued interest.


