18 WHEREAS on March 29, 2020, Order of the Chief Judge No. 20-043 was  
19 issued authorizing the use of video and telephonic conference technology in certain  
20 criminal proceedings under the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act  
21 (“CARES Act”);

22 WHEREAS on June 26, 2020, Order of the Chief Judge No. 20-080 was issued  
23 extending all findings and authorizations in Order of the Chief Judge No. 20-043 for an  
24 additional 90 days;

25 WHEREAS the emergency authority granted under the CARES Act has not  
26 been terminated; and

27 WHEREAS the authorizations granted in Order of the Chief Judge No. 20-043  
28 continue to be warranted;

1           Acting pursuant to Section 15002(b) of the CARES Act and having conducted  
2 the necessary review, I hereby extend all findings and authorizations in Order of the  
3 Chief Judge No. 20-043 for an additional 90 days unless terminated earlier. If the  
4 emergency persists longer than 90 days, I will review the situation for further  
5 extension of authority pursuant to the provisions of the CARES Act.
