This General Order amends General Order 05-07 to add the following provision regarding the unavailability of a magistrate judge:

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, in the event of prolonged illness, disability, or other unavoidable unavailability of a magistrate judge, the Case Management and Assignment Committee or the Chief District Judge, in consultation with the Case Management and Assignment Committee Chair, may transfer from the calendar of such judge any matters deemed necessary to expedite the business of the Court and to promote the prompt administration of justice. The Clerk will reassign such matters in the same manner as an original assignment or as otherwise directed by the Case Management and Assignment Committee Chair. In addition, the Chief District Judge, in consultation with the Case Management and Assignment Committee and the Chief Magistrate Judge, may remove a magistrate judge from one or more decks when the
