GENERAL ORDER NO. 224-D

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that General Order 224 be amended as follows:

Upon the acceptance by the Court of a transfer to this district of supervision of a probationer or person on supervised release pursuant to U.S.C. 18 §3605, the matter shall be given a criminal case number and shall be randomly assigned to a district judge for no case credit.

Subsequent transfers-in involving the same probationer or person on supervised release shall be directly assigned for no case credit to the district judge to whom the first matter was assigned.
