GENERAL ORDER NO. 339-A

General Order No. 339 deferred the implementation of the 1993 Amendments to Rules 5(e), 16(b), 26(a)(1), 26(a)(2)(C), 26(a)(3), 26(a)(4), 26(b)(2), 26(d), 29, 30(d)(2), 32(c) and 54(d)(2)(D) of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure (the "Amendments") for a six-month period, from December 1, 1993 to June 1, 1994.

Because of the need for further study, by the Court and its Rules Committee, of the effect the Amendments will have on the existing Local Rules and practice in this District, the Court now further defers the effective date of the Amendments from June 1 to September 1, 1994.

All other provisions of General Order No. 339 remain in effect.
