22	WHEREAS all findings and authorizations in Order of the Chief Judge No. 20-	
23	043 have been previously extended for additional 90-day periods through Orders of the

25	WHEREAS the emergency authority granted under the CARES Act has not	

been terminated; and

> WHEREAS the authorizations granted in Order of the Chief Judge No. 20-043 continue to be warranted;

Acting pursuant to Section 15002(b) of the CARES Act and having conducted the necessary review, I hereby extend all findings and authorizations in Order of the Chief Judge No. 20-043 until July 15, 2021, unless terminated earlier. If the emergency persists at that time, I will review the situation for further extension of authority pursuant to the provisions of the CARES Act.
