ORDER OF THE CHIEF JUDGE  
21-073

18 WHEREAS on March 29, 2020, Order of the Chief Judge No. 20-043 was  
19 issued authorizing the use of video and telephonic conference technology in certain  
20 criminal proceedings under the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act  
21 (“CARES Act”);

22 WHEREAS all findings and authorizations in Order of the Chief Judge No. 20-  
23 043 have been previously extended for additional 90-day periods through Orders of the  
24 Chief Judge Nos. 20-080, 20-079, 20-186, and 21-031;

25 WHEREAS on June 11, 2021, Order of the Chief Judge No. 21-060 was issued  
26 extending these findings until July 15, 2021;

27 WHEREAS on July 2, 2021, Order of the Chief Judge No. 21-065 was issued  
28 extending these findings until August 15, 2021;

1           WHEREAS the emergency authority granted under the CARES Act has not  
2 been terminated; and

3           WHEREAS the authorizations granted in Order of the Chief Judge No. 20-043  
4 continue to be warranted;

5           Acting pursuant to Section 15002(b) of the CARES Act and having conducted  
6 the necessary review, I hereby extend all findings and authorizations in Order of the  
7 Chief Judge No. 20-043 until October 15, 2021, unless terminated earlier. If the  
8 emergency persists at that time, I will review the situation for further extension of  
9 authority pursuant to the provisions of the CARES Act.
