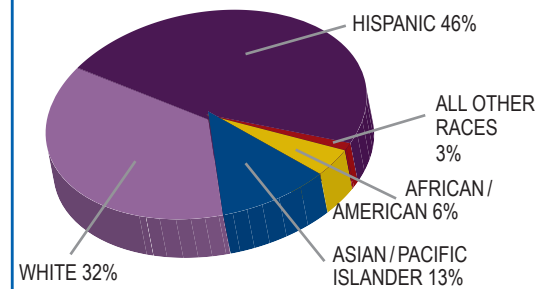
The Central District of California

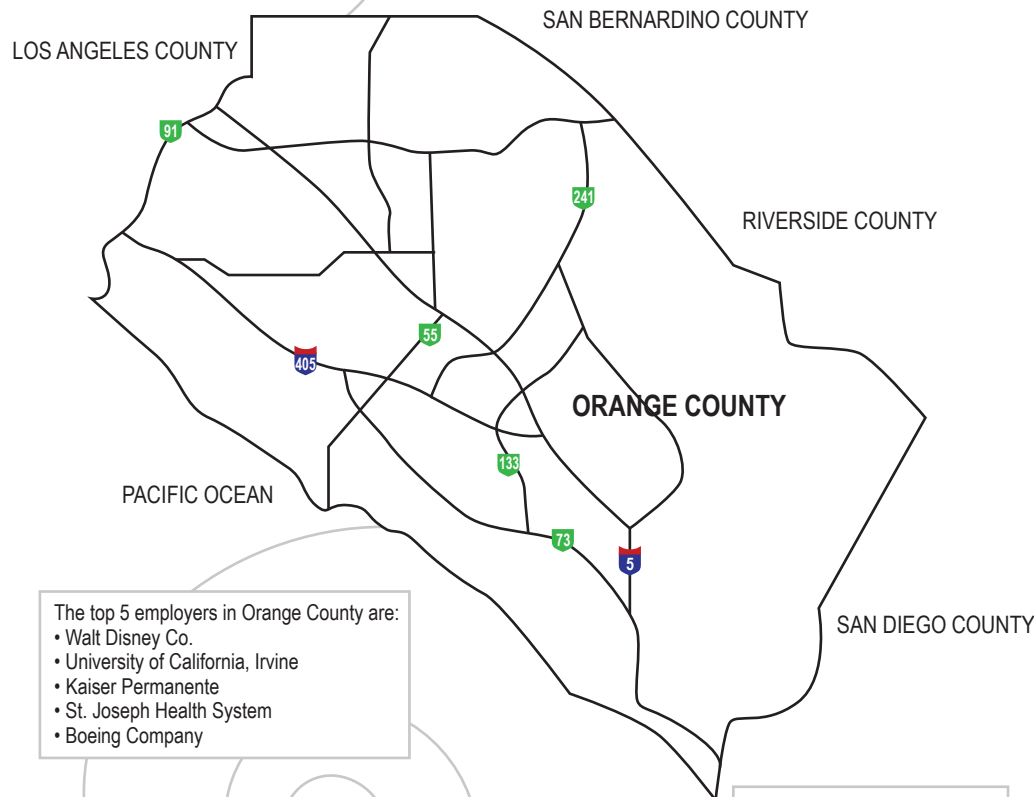
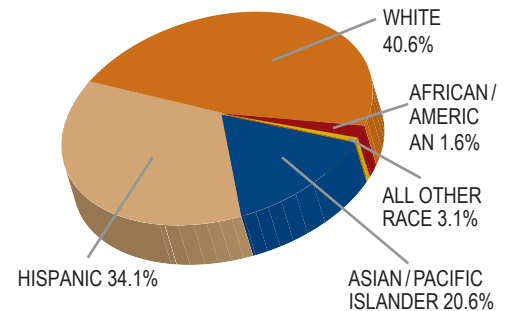


Orange County is the third largest population in California, and the sixth largest in the US—larger than 22 states, including Iowa, Mississippi, Kansas and Utah.

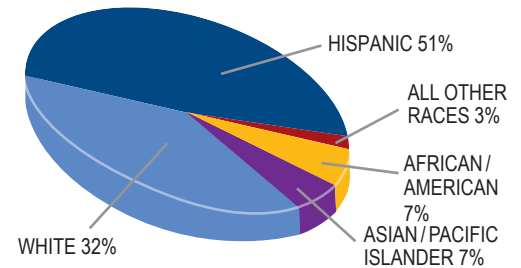

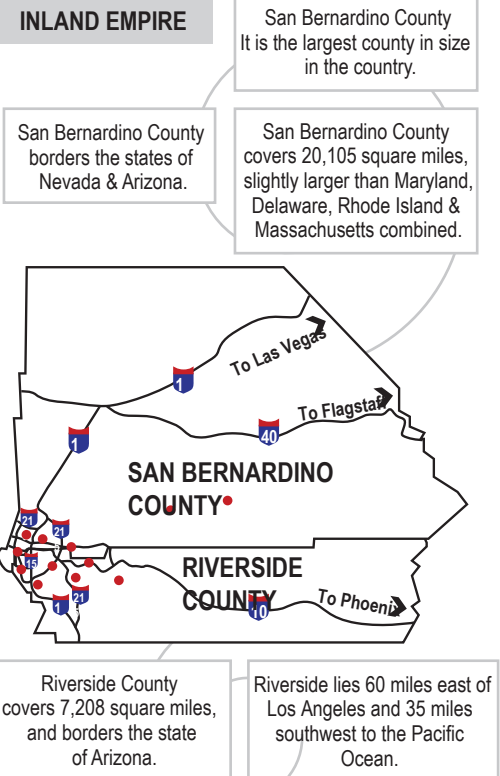
