The United States of America hereby moves for a stay of Action in
the above-captioned case.

1 1. At the end of the day on September 30, 2025, appropriations to the
2 Department of Justice lapsed. The Department does not know when funding will
3 be restored by Congress.

4 2. Absent an appropriation, Department of Justice attorneys are
5 prohibited from working, even on a voluntary basis, except in very limited
6 circumstances, including “emergencies involving the safety of human life or the
7 protection of property.” 31 U.S.C. § 1342.

8 3. Undersigned counsel for the Department of Justice therefore requests
9 a stay of the case at bar until Congress has restored appropriations to the
10 Department.

11 4. If this motion for a stay is granted, undersigned counsel will notify the
12 Court as soon as Congress has appropriated funds for the Department. The
13 Government requests that, at that point, all current deadlines for the parties be
14 extended commensurate with the duration of the lapse in appropriations (i.e., each
15 deadline would be extended by the total number of days of the lapse in
16 appropriations).

17 5. Defendants have not yet been served therefore there is no current
18 counsel of record on behalf of Defendants at this time.

19 Therefore, although we greatly regret any disruption caused to the
20 Court and the other litigants, the Government hereby moves for a stay of this
21 Action until Department of Justice attorneys are permitted to resume their usual
22 civil litigation functions.

6 Defendants have not yet been served therefore there is no current counsel of
7 record on behalf of Defendants at this time.

8 IT IS SO ORDERED, that Plaintiff’s Motion to Stay in Light of Lapse
9 in Appropriations is GRANTED.

10 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all current deadlines for the parties
11 be extended commensurate with the duration of the lapse in appropriations (i.e.,
12 each deadline would be extended by the total number of days of the lapse in
13 appropriations).
