(IN CHAMBERS) MEMORANDUM RE FAIRNESS HEARING

Proceedings:

- 1. Courtroom 10C will be open at 8:00 a.m. Seating will be on a first-come basis, except as follows. Two rows will be reserved for objectors who have previously given timely notice of their intent to appear. (A list of such objectors is attached hereto.) The jury box will be reserved for the press. (The jury box holds 14.)
- 2. For those who cannot be accommodated in Courtroom 10C, there will be overflow seating in the Jury Assembly Room on the first floor. There will be a one-way audio and video feed.
- 3. Objectors and others who have given timely notice of intent to address the Court shall check in with the clerk in Jury Assembly Room on the first floor no later than 8:30 a.m. to receive a pink card. This will allow the person to be seated in the reserved rows.
- 4. Any person who is hearing impaired and needs the use of an assisted listening device shall check in with the clerk in Jury Assembly Room on the first floor no later than 8:30 a.m. to receive a blue card which will allow the person to receive a device

 - 7. The hearing will proceed as follows:
- The economic loss class plaintiffs may address the merits of the motion for approval and the motion for attorney's fees.
 - Toyota will have an opportunity to respond.
- Each objector who has given timely notice of intent to address the Court will have ten minutes. Objectors will be invited to the lectern in the order in which their objections appear in the docket. The Court has read and considered all objections, and the Court will not take a decision to submit on a written objection or to make briefer remark as less than full and vigorous support for the objector's written position.
