

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## Weighted Filings per Judgeship



The number of weighted filings per judgeship for the Central District of California rose significantly to 691 for fiscal year<sup>1</sup> ("FY") 2019, an increase of 10 percent from 627 a year ago. Weighted filings have increased 27 percent over the five-year period from FY2015 to FY2019. The national average was 535 weighted filings per judgeship. The Central District of California ranked 13<sup>th</sup> in the nation and 3<sup>rd</sup> in the Ninth Circuit for weighted filings in FY2019.

The Central District of California has 28 authorized Article III judgeships. At the end of FY2019, the Central District had nine vacancies, triple from FY2016. The oldest vacancy is from August 1, 2014. In 2016 through 2018, two additional vacancies arose each year. At the end of FY2019, the number of vacant judgeship months was the highest in the Court's history at 94.7 months. Vacant judgeship months are the total number of months that vacancies occurred in any judgeship position in a circuit or district.



In FY2019, the Central District of California saw an 0.9 percent increase in combined civil and criminal case filings from FY2018. Total case terminations increased 8.1 percent, and total pending cases increased 3 percent from FY2018. During the five-year period ending September 30, 2019, total civil and criminal case filings increased by 9.3 percent; total terminations increased by 5.7 percent, and total pending cases rose 16.4 percent.


A total of 15,514 civil cases were filed in FY2019, an increase of 1.2 percent from 15,335 in FY2018. Terminations increased 8.6 percent, and pending civil cases increased 2.3 percent from FY2018. During the five-year period ending September 30, 2019, civil case filings increased 6.6 percent, terminations increased 4.3 percent, and pending civil cases rose 13.4 percent, representing five-year highs.





Between FY2015 and FY2019, the total number of criminal case filings surged 64.5 percent, and criminal defendant filings rose 65.7 percent, a five-year high. In FY2019, criminal case filings in the District decreased 2.7 percent, and filings for criminal defendants increased 5.5 percent from FY2018. In FY2019, criminal case terminations in the Central District of California increased 1.2 percent; terminations for criminal defendants increased 2.1 percent; pending criminal cases increased 6.2 percent; and, pending criminal defendants increased 9.7 percent from FY2018.






## **Civil Case Filings**



Civil rights case filings constituted the highest percentage of all civil case filing categories at 33.2 percent in FY2019. There were more civil rights, personal injury/product liability, and all other civil filed in FY2019; however, there were fewer contracts, social security, and copyright, patent and trademark cases filed compared to FY2018. In FY2019, personal injury/product liability case filings increased 126 percent.






The Americans With Disabilities Act (ADA) Civil Rights filings in FY 2019 comprised 21.7 percent of California Central District's total civil filings. From FY 2018 to FY 2019 ADA filings increased 31.2 percent, and over the five-year period, from FY 2015 to FY 2019, ADA filings have increased 223.5 percent. ADA filings have surged, and from FY 2015 through FY 2019 while total civil filings increased 6.6 percent, the percentage of ADA filings to total civil filings have increased 203.4 percent.




## **Civil Removal Filings**



A total of 3,624 civil removal cases were filed in FY2019, a decrease of 13.3 percent from FY2018. Civil removal filings represented 23.4 percent of the total filings in the Central District of California: 69 percent of the removals were filed in the Western Division; 13 percent were filed in the Southern Division; and, 18 percent were filed in the Eastern Division. The largest percentage of civil removal filings were civil rights (24 percent) and contracts (23 percent) cases.



## **Non-Prisoner Pro Se Filings**




12 percent of the 15,514 total civil cases filed in FY2019 were non-prisoner cases with at least one pro se party.<sup>2</sup> Of these, 62 percent were real property and civil rights cases.


## **Criminal Defendant Filings**



In FY2019, criminal defendant filings increased 5.5 percent from FY2018. The top three major offense categories for criminal defendant filings in FY2019 were drug offenses (38 percent), property offenses (27 percent), and immigration offenses (9 percent). The number of defendants charged with drug offenses increased by 20.2 percent, the number of defendants charged with property offenses increased by 0.8 percent, and the number of defendants charged with immigration offenses decreased by 16.6 percent from FY2018.





#### Civil Case Filings Referred to Magistrate Judges for Report and Recommendation




In FY2019, 17.7 percent of the total civil filings were referred to Magistrate Judges for report and recommendations. Of the cases referred for report and recommendations, 35 percent were habeas corpus petitions, 31 percent were Social Security appeal cases, 23 percent were prisoner civil rights cases, 9 percent were non-prisoner pro se civil rights cases, and 1 percent were other cases referred for report and recommendations.




## **Consents to Magistrate Judge**

2019 Consents to Magistrate Judges 12-Month Period Ending December 31, 2019



Parties consented to proceed before Magistrate Judges in a total of 848 cases in calendar year 2019, a 15.3 percent decrease from 2018. Of this total, all parties consented in 762 cases that were referred to a Magistrate Judge for a report and recommendation; all parties consented in 41 cases assigned to Magistrate Judges through the Direct Assignment of Civil Cases to Magistrate Judges Program; and, all parties consented to proceed before Magistrate Judges in 37 cases through the Voluntary Consent List of Civil Cases to Magistrate Judges Program.

In calendar year 2019, Magistrate Judges held 371 settlement conferences in 343 cases. Of these, the Magistrate Judges settled 177 cases, for a 52 percent settlement rate. The Magistrate Judges spent a total of 1,834 hours, equivalent to 229 8-hour-work days, on settling these cases.



In calendar year 2019, six District Judges participated in the Patent Pilot Program in the Central District of California. In 2019, the Judges designated to receive patent cases under the Patent Pilot Program received 225 patent cases, of which 63 were initially assigned to them, 87 cases were transferred to the program from non-participating Judges, and 75 cases were transferred to the program as a result of related case transfers or other reasons. The number of patent cases filed in calendar year 2019 increased by 14 percent, and the number of cases transferred to the program by non-participating Judges increased by 45 percent from 2018. In 2019, the percentage of patent cases filed that were assigned or transferred to Judges participating in the Patent Pilot Program was 69 percent. Since the start of the Patent Pilot Program in September of 2011, a total of 1,707 patent cases have been assigned to participating judges.






In calendar year 2019, a total of 177 trials were held before all Judges in the Central District of California, a 21 percent decrease from 2018. In 2019, of the 177 trials, 73 percent were jury trials, and 27 percent were bench trials. From 2018 to 2019, civil jury trials dropped 25 percent; civil bench trials decreased 7 percent; criminal jury trials decreased 13 percent, and criminal bench trials decreased by 65 percent. During the five-year period ending December 31, 2019, trials decreased 7 percent overall.







In calendar year 2019, there were 19,831 jurors in attendance for the Central District of California, a 1 percent increase from 2018. Over the five-year period ending December 31, 2019, the number of jurors in attendance decreased 6 percent from 21,050 in 2015.
