

FAQ re Court Operations During COOP

External Questions

1. I am pro se and do not have computer/internet access. I always come in to personally file my documents and get my notices in the mail. If the court is closed for filing, how can I submit my documents as ordered by the judge without being penalized?

Mail your documents to Clerk of Court at 255 East Temple Street, Suite TS-134, Los Angeles, CA 90012-3332. You will continue to receive notices and court-issued documents in the mail.

2. For criminal duty matters conducted at the Roybal Courthouse, may a family member or member of the media attend the hearing?

Yes; however, social distancing must be observed in the courtroom.

3. Are chambers paper copies still required?

Until further notice, all district judges and magistrate judges do not require mandatory chambers copies during the pandemic.

Any judge can require a chambers copy in a particular case if desired. The chambers copy shall be mailed to the judge via Fed Ex. Chambers copy cannot be hand-delivered to the courthouse.
