**PROCEEDINGS (IN CHAMBERS): ORDER REQUIRING MEET-AND-
CONFER AND SETTING STATUS
CONFERENCE**

On June 12, 2026, Los Angeles City Councilwoman Monica Rodriguez sent a letter to this Court “respectfully request[ing] that the Court order the County to provide a report detailing: (1) The number of severely mentally ill (SMI) individuals who have been transitioned from City-funded sites into County-operated programs and systems of care; (2) A comprehensive breakdown of the SMI who remain in City-funded sites and require County-supported long-term care; and (3) A detailed plan and timeline for transitioning those individuals from City-funded sites into the appropriate County care and housing programs.” Letter from Councilwoman Rodriguez (Dkt. 1310).

In light of Plaintiff LA Alliance’s response (Dkt. 1314) and the subsequent response by the County of Los Angeles (the “County”) (Dkt. 1315) the Court **ORDERS** the Parties, including Intervenor; County Special Master Justice Thomas Goethals (Ret.); and City Special Master Michele Martinez to meet and confer on the County’s compliance with the settlement agreement and any related issues. The meet and confer

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shall commence at a time and place as agreed by all concerned and shall be completed by August 6, 2026.

The Court **SETS** a Status Conference regarding an update on this matter and any efforts by the County to cure under the applicable dispute resolution procedures. The Status Conference shall occur on August 26, 2026 at 9:00 a.m. in Courtroom One in Los Angeles.

The Clerk shall serve this minute order on the parties.
