**PROCEEDINGS (IN CHAMBERS): ORDER REQUIRING
ATTENDANCE AT AUGUST 6, 2026
HEARING**

The Los Angeles Homeless Services Authority (“LAHSA”) recently filed a lawsuit against the federal government “seek[ing] injunctive relief restraining Defendants from preventing it from providing its services to homeless individuals, including with federal funds.” Order (Dkt. 21), *LAHSA v. Trump* (the “*LAHSA Case*”), Case No. 2:26-cv-07056-DOC-AJR (C.D. Cal. July 2, 2026). This case implicates the provision of homeless services within Los Angeles and thus impacts the instant case. *See* Notice of Related Cases (Dkt. 16), Case No. 2:26-cv-07056-DOC-AJR (C.D. Cal. June 29, 2026). Accordingly, the Court **ORDERS** that all Parties—the City of Los Angeles, County of Los Angeles, Plaintiffs, and Intervenors—appear in-person at the upcoming August 6, 2026 hearing on a preliminary injunction in the *LAHSA Case*. The hearing will take place at 9:00 a.m. in Courtroom One in the First Street Courthouse in Los Angeles.

The Court has also been informed by County Special Master Justice Thomas Goethals (Ret.) that the Parties have set a tentative date of July 20, 2026 for their meet-and-confer efforts. As such, the Parties may also share updates regarding their meet-and-confer efforts at the August 6, 2026 hearing.

The Clerk shall serve this minute order on the parties.
