**PROCEEDINGS (IN CHAMBERS): ORDER SETTING PRELIMINARY
INJUNCTION HEARING AND
BRIEFING SCHEDULE**

On June 29, 2026 Plaintiff Los Angeles Homeless Services Authority (“LAHSA”) filed its Complaint (Dkt. 1) in this Court. Plaintiff filed a notice that it will be seeking an ex parte temporary restraining order (“Application”) on the same day (Dkt. 8). Plaintiff seeks injunctive relief restraining Defendants from preventing it from providing its services to homeless individuals, including with federal funds.

After consideration, the Court concludes that it should not decide the Application on an ex parte basis and the government must have adequate time to brief this issue. This is especially important in light of the oversized brief that Plaintiff will file in support of its request (Dkt. 15). Accordingly, it converts the Application into a Motion for Preliminary Injunction and sets the following briefing schedule: Defendants’ Opposition brief¹ shall be due no later than July 13, 2026 and Plaintiff’s Reply brief shall be due no later than July 20, 2026. The Court sets a hearing on the Motion for Preliminary Injunction for August 6, 2026 at 9:00 a.m. in Courtroom One in the First Street Courthouse in Los Angeles.

¹ In light of Plaintiff’s significantly oversized brief, Defendants may file a brief of up to fifty-one pages in their Opposition.

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In addition, the Court **ORDERS** the Parties to submit, by no later than July 16, 2026, a Stipulated Proposed Order maintaining the status quo with respect to LAHSA's provision of services until the Court has the opportunity to rule on the preliminary injunction. The Court takes judicial notice that "[t]he [current] deadline for the L.A. region to submit its application to HUD for regional homelessness grants is Aug. 26." *See Aaraon Schrank, Lawsuit filed over frozen federal funding*, LAIST (Jun 29, 2026 4:36 p.m.), <http://laist.com/brief/news/housing-homelessness/lahsa-homeless-los-angeles-sue-hud-trump-mismanagement-fraud-contiuum-of-care-funding>. The Court will endeavor to issue a ruling in this matter before this deadline passes, and request that the Parties keep the Court apprised of any updates to this deadline.

The Parties are **ORDERED** to provide courtesy copies to chambers of every filing in this matter from this point forward, and also for all past filings.

The Clerk shall serve this minute order on the parties.
