**Proceedings: HEARING REGARDING TRIAL EXHIBITS**

(1) On January 26, 2016, at 10:00 a.m., in Courtroom 2 of the above-entitled court, counsel for each party shall produce the trial exhibits previously returned to them pursuant to the "Receipt for Release of Exhibits to Counsel" (Doc. Counsel may submit transcripts of lengthy audio recordings in lieu of the recordings that were introduced into evidence at trial.

(2) Counsel for any party may file and serve briefing no later than January 15, 2016, regarding the need for special procedures for the handling of any exhibit. The matter is set for hearing on Tuesday, January 26, 2016 at 9:00 a.m.
