19 II. Discontinuances.

20
21 The Court did not received an application from Monica R. Kelley,
22 previously appointed Plaintiffs’ Lead Counsel for the Foreign Economic Loss
23 Class Action. In view of the disposition of the foreign economic loss claims
24 (Docket No. 2004), the Court terminates Ms. Kelly’s appointment. Because there
25 appear to be no continuing issues of foreign law, the Court also terminates Ms.
26 Kelly’s appointment as consultant to the Liaison Committee for Personal
27 Injury/Wrongful Death Cases and the Lead Counsel Committee for Economic Loss

1 Class Actions on foreign law issues.
2

3 The Court did not receive an application from Jerome L. Ringler, a
4 member of Plaintiffs' Lead Counsel Committee for Economic Loss Class Actions.
5 The Court terminates Mr. Ringler's appointment.
6

7 In light of his commitments to individual MDL cases and
8 commitments in other matters, W. Mark Lanier has withdrawn his request for
9 reappointment as a member of the Plaintiffs' Liaison Committee for Personal
10 Injury/Wrongful Death Cases.

11 The Court thanks Ms. Kelly, Mr. Ringler, and Mr. Lanier for their
12 time devoted to these proceedings.
