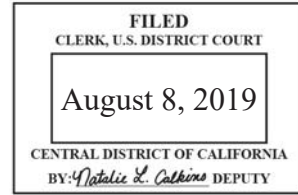

BEYOND THE AGE OF 70)

Pursuant to the Federal Magistrates Act of 1979 (Pub. L. No. 96-82), 28 U.S.C. § 631(d), a sitting Magistrate Judge may serve beyond the age of 70 with the approval of a majority of all of the District Judges of the Court, with such approval required upon the Magistrate Judge’s reaching of the age of 70 and annually thereafter.

Magistrate Judge John E. McDermott reached the age of 70 on October 25, 2016.

Upon recommendation of the Executive Committee, and with the concurrence of a majority of all the District Judges of the Court, the Court voted to approve the continued service of Magistrate Judge John E. McDermott during its meeting held on August 7, 2019.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Magistrate Judge John E. McDermott shall continue to serve as a Magistrate Judge of the United States District Court for the

1 Central District of California until this issue is addressed again upon his next birth
2 date on October 25, 2020.
