GENERAL ORDER NO. 25-06

Upon recommendation of the Executive Committee and with the concurrence of a majority of all the District Judges of the Court, pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 631, the Federal Magistrate Act of 1979 (Pub. L. No. 96-82), and the standards and procedures promulgated by the Judicial Conference of the United States,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Daniel S. Roberts be, and hereby is, appointed as a Full-Time United States Magistrate Judge for the Central District of California for the full term of eight (8) years from the date of such appointment.

Said term of Daniel S. Roberts shall commence upon the taking of his oath of office as a United States Magistrate Judge, at the salary fixed by the Judicial Conference of the United States, with his official duty station being designated at Los Angeles, California.
